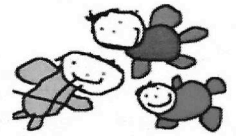

Dear Parent/Carers,

In January 2014, one of the year 6 pupils Kyle at St Bede C of E Primary Academy was diagnosed with a rare muscle tissue cancer called Rhabdomyosarcoma. During intensive treatment, a drug had an adverse affect and he became deaf in July 2014. Giving it his all, he fought hard but unfortunately relapsed in May 2015. He then underwent a course of chemotherapy and twenty-five sessions of radiotherapy and was given the all clear in December 2015. In March of this year, Kyle had his three-month routine scan, which showed the cancer had returned. Kyle is once again starting treatment to keep the cancer at bay until a trial becomes available and is offered.

Throughout his illness, Kyle has remained so positive and has a constant smile on his face. There are some options open to Kyle, which involve him travelling to America for treatment. As you can imagine, this is an expensive option, but one that we feel is extremely important.

On Friday 13th May, we have decided to hold a non-uniform day, costing £1.00 each to wear something yellow, all donations will go directly to Kyle and will support and help him with his treatment.
