Event starts and 9.00 am until 9.30 am.


Dinner Money

School dinner money should be paid on a Monday. It should be put into an envelope with the name of your child and class written on it. It should be handed to the **class teacher** and not to the office unless you are paying in advance.

The cost of a school dinner has increased to £1.40 a day or £7.00 per week. The meals are ordered a week in advance so if you want to change from school meals to a packed lunch, then you must let school know in writing the week before. This request should be handed into the school office.
