- Practise forming the letters of the alphabet clearly and consistently.



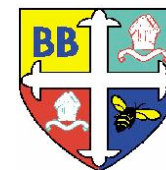
Numeracy

- Counting on and back in 1s

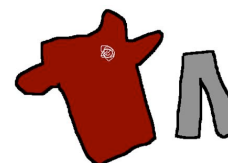
