Numeracy - Please support children in completing their homework but don't do it for them!

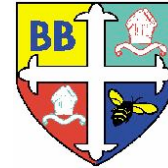

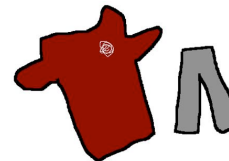
