Numeracy - Please support children in completing their homework, but don't do it for them!

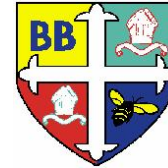

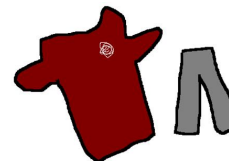

Half Termly Overview of Work



Literacy

This term we're looking at Playscripts. Children will be reading a variety of Playscripts and the associated features. They will have the opportunity read and act out different scripts before writing a play of their own.



Numeracy

Children will be revisiting and revising many of the areas covered previously in the year - Multiplication facts, addition and subtraction, multiplication and division, 2D shape, decimals - addition and subtraction and 3D shape.

Science
