Reading

This year, we expect children to be reading at least 5 times a week. This can be either a school reading book or any other reading material. Please read with your child and make a record of this in their homework diaries. Children may also receive homework relating to their school reading book once a week.



Writing

In year 4 we encourage children to practice their times tables and number bonds on a regular basis, so that this will help them learn other areas of Mathematics.



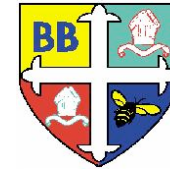

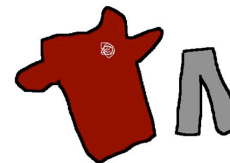

Half Termly Overview of Work



Literacy

In Literacy this half term we will be focusing on the talk for writing text 'Riley'. We will be using this text as a focus for writing and building on our comprehension skills. We will be focusing on engaging writing using adjectives, adverbs and connectives. We will be focusing on learning Alan Peat sentence types as part of our writing.



Numeracy
