Reading

Listen to your child read at least 3 times a week. Ask them questions about the book and check their understanding. We will be sending a reading test home, every week, up until SATs. Please make sure your child complete this test under test conditions for 1 hour.



Play

You can help your child by supporting when researching about new concepts and ideas in science and topic.



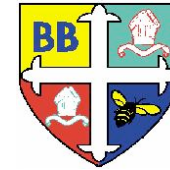

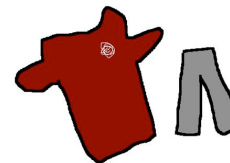
