### Reading

Reading books in reception and library books in nursery will continue to come home. Please make sure you read regularly and sign your child's reading record.



### Writing

In class, we are focusing on learning to write our names and to correctly form the letters taught through phonics- using and applying them in our writing.

**We discourage the children from copying or tracing letters, and encourage the formation of letters independently. If you're not sure how to encourage your child at home, please call in and see your child's teacher.**

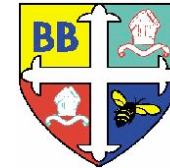
### Mathematics

This half term we will be consolidating our number work. In reception we are thinking about teen numbers, and being confident to count to 20.

We are also problem solving , doubling and halving. In nursery the children are learning about 2D shapes, and will continue to practice counting to 10 [and beyond]

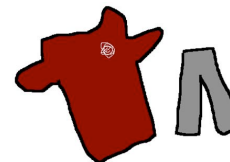

## Half Termly Overview of Work



Literacy: In Nursery and Reception, the children are writing for a purpose, writing invitations, cards and lists.

In both Nursery and Reception we will continue to sing nursery rhymes and number rhymes daily.



Mathematics – This term we will be:

- Continuing to count reliably with numbers from one to 10 in Nursery and 20 in Reception; and place them in order.
- Solving practical problems
- Doubling and halving

#### Phonics

This half term we will continue Letters and Sounds phonics Phase 1, 2 and 3.

Phase 1- This will include tuning into sounds in the environment as well as in words.

Phase 2- Children will continue to progress through the phase 2 sounds  
s,a,t,p,i,n,m,d,g,o,c,k,ck,e,u,r,b,f,h,l : we are now encouraging the children to apply these sounds into words.

Phase 3- digraphs: 2 letters, 1 sound: ch, sh, th, ai, ee, igh, oa, oo, ar, or, ur, ow, oi, ear, air, ure, er.

Phase 1 is where the children in Nursery are developing their skills and phase 2 and 3 is where the Reception children are being taught although we are still practicing phase 1 games too.



RE - This half term the topic is 'TRUST'

Computing – Reception will continue to visit the ICT suite every week to practice logging on to the computers independently.



PE – nursery and reception will be having actiphons sessions with our coach This is developing phonics skills whilst playing physical games.

Your child needs a NAMED PE kit in school each week.



Homework - In Nursery and Reception, we send home challenges home. These are fun to do and can be done as part of your family adventures each weekend.
