Reading

Writing

- Encourage your child to write as often as possible for example by making lists, reading and writing stories and descriptions etc.
- Practise forming the letters of the alphabet clearly and consistently.



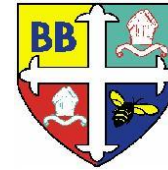
Numeracy

- Recognising amounts of money
- Number bonds to 10 and 20 e.g. $3 + 7 = 10$, $4 + 6 = 10$
- Counting on and back in 1s
- Counting in 2's, 5's and 10's

Half Termly Overview of Work



Literacy

This term in Literacy we will be learning about Poetry and Traditional Tales. We will explore a selection of poems and write our own. We will look in detail at the features of Fairytales and become familiar with key fairy stories.



Numeracy

This term in Numeracy we will be recognising coins, adding amounts of money and finding how to give change. We will be completing calculations such as addition and subtraction and will look at 2D and 3D shapes. We will also look at missing number and fractions.

Science
