Writing: Please ensure that your child learns their spellings every week, we would love to see everyone get 10 out of 10. Spelling tests will take place every Friday morning.



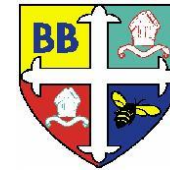
Numeracy: Practise your times tables at home, this is a really great skill to help with lots of different numeracy tasks.

Half Termly Overview of Work

Literacy

We are really looking forward to learning about adventure stories. We will be looking closely at 'The Tunnel' by Anthony Browne. We will be looking at the five parts of a story in order to construct our own exciting story. We will be using different sentence types including 2 part sentences with a conjunction in the middle.



Numeracy: We will be really busy this half term, looking at fractions including fractions on a number line, and identifying equivalent fractions for a half. We will also be looking at word problems including two step problems. We will revise multiplication and division. We will also be doing lots of preparation and practise for SATs.
