

How You can Help at home.



Reading - please read with your child at least **4 times** every week (more if possible). Please record each reading session in their diary on the page where the book was issued. Children will receive rewards for reading 4 times a week. Use the local library and share their school library book with them. Children will also have a leveled reading book of their own choice.



Writing - Please encourage your child to write at all available opportunities. Help them to learn spellings by asking them to Look, Say, Cover, Write and then Check their words.



Numeracy - Please support children in completing their homework but don't do it for them! Help children to learn their Times Tables and the corresponding division facts.

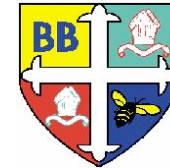

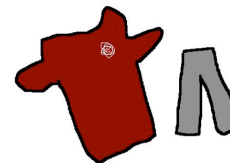

Half Termly Overview of Work



Literacy

This term we will be using an old legend called Beowulf for our Literacy focus. Children will explore the genre of legends, myths, fables. They will then write an alternative legend based on Beowulf. In the last part of the term we will be looking at Poetry.



Numeracy - Place value, fractions, written and mental division, measures and calculations in Volume, Capacity and Mass.

Class Routines



Dinner Money - to be paid on a Monday morning in a sealed envelope with the child's name on.



PE Kit - white T-shirt, Black shorts/trousers, pumps (indoors) trainers (outside).



Snack - morning (fruit/healthy alternative) - £1 per week. Paid on Monday morning (separate from dinner money).

They will also learn about daily life, clothes, schooling etc. At the end of the term we will have a Viking/Saxon dressing up day.
