

How You can Help at home.



Reading - please read with your child at least **4 times** every week (more if possible). Please record each reading session in their diary on the page where the book was issued. Children will receive rewards for reading 4 times a week. Use the local library and share their school library book with them. Children will also have a leveled reading book of their own choice.



Writing - Please encourage your child to write at all available opportunities. Help them to learn spellings by asking them to Look, Say, Cover, Write and then Check their words.



Numeracy - Please support children in completing their homework but don't do it for them! Help children to learn their Times Tables and the corresponding division facts.

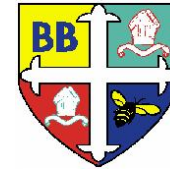

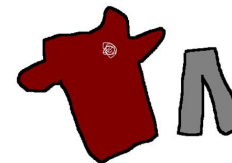

Half Termly Overview of Work



Literacy -

This term we will be studying and writing an Explanation text. We will focus on an imaginary text for catching a Manchester Ridgeback Dragon. Children will explore some of the features of an Explanation text and then use them in writing their own explanation of how to catch an alternative imaginary creature.



Numeracy - Place Value, 2d and 3d shapes, addition and subtraction through data handling, time, multiplication methods. We will also focus on developing a deeper understanding of mathematical concepts - Mastery.

Class Routines



Dinner Money - to be paid on a Monday morning in a sealed envelope with the child's name on.

We will study 3 important artists from Spain (Dali, Picasso, Gaudi) - they will replicate some of their art. We are hoping to arrange a visit to Bolton Museum for a 'Art' work shop.

RE - Joy, Sadness, Joy - emotions related to the Easter Story.



Computing - Writing our own computer programs - using Scratch.
