Numeracy

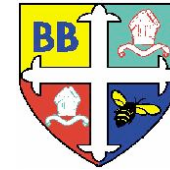

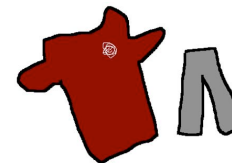

Half Termly Overview of Work



Literacy

In literacy this half term we will be focusing on stories from an imaginary world and will be reading the text "The Story Thief." We will be developing our reciprocal reading skills and clarifying, summarising, predicting and questioning.



Numeracy

In numeracy this half term we will be working on time, multiplication, division, statistics, perimeter and 3D shape. Alongside this we will continue to test and support the children with their Mental Arithmetic.

School Trips

Science

This half term our topic is States of Matter. We will be comparing and grouping materials together, according to whether they are solids, liquids or gases. We will be exploring what happens to different materials when they are heated and cooled. Children will also be learning all about the water cycle and the processes of evaporation and condensation.



Topic

In year 4 this half term, we will be learning all about Ancient Egypt. We will be learning all about life in Ancient Egypt, hieroglyphs, Pharaohs and Gods, the importance of the River Nile and how Egypt has changed over time. We will also be focusing on art and designing our own tombs.
