Numeracy

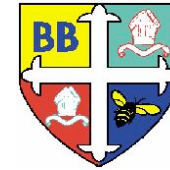

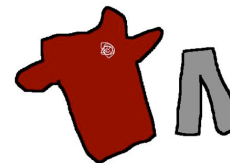

Literacy

In Literacy this half term we will be learning how to write a newspaper report. The children will look at a current report, discuss it's key features and then use this knowledge to create their own newspaper article. We will also be using Makaton signals (sign language) whilst reading their newspaper articles to

In Numeracy this half term we will be focusing on decimals, dividing by 10 and 100, telling the time and coordinates. We will also be practicing multiplication tables on a daily basis. As usual, presentation is crucial in Numeracy as it aids the children's understanding of place value.

Science

This half term we will be learning about living things and their habitats. In our lessons about living things, we will be exploring different types of habitats. We will also observe how habitats change and how that poses a threat to the inhabitants. We will work scientifically to group and record different living things in various types of habitats. We have also invited Zoolab to come in and show the children different animals and discuss their habitats.



Topic

This half term we will be continuing our learning about ancient Egyptians. We will learn about the Pyramids, Egyptian gods and their temples, as well as Tutankhamen.

The topic will have a history focus, but some geography and DT elements will be taught with regards to Egypt's local ecosystem and artwork.

Computing
