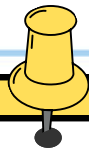
JLT

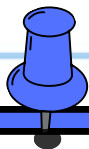




80TH ANNIVERSARY OF D-DAY

PHONICS SCREENING

Phonics screening checks (PSC) will be taking place next week.

The PSC is a check of your child's phonics knowledge. It helps us confirm whether your child is making the progress expected in the national curriculum.

Phonics is an effective way of teaching children to read. We ensure we deliver high quality phonics teaching as we want to improve literacy levels and give all our children a solid base to build on as they progress through school.



MULTIPLICATION CHECKS

Multiplication checks (MTC) have been taking place this week and will continue into next week.

The purpose of the check is to determine whether your child can fluently recall their times tables up to 12, which is essential for future success in mathematics.

It is an on-screen check consisting of 25 times table questions. Children have 6 seconds to answer each question. On average, the check should take no longer than 5 minutes to complete.
